POLICY PURPOSE

It is the policy of Communicare Academy that all students enrolled at Communicare Academy identify with the school through attendance of class and in their form and standard of dress. While a formal uniform is not imposed, it is expected that students will dress in a manner that reflects an education facility and an appropriate standard is required. A school polo shirt for warmer weather and a long sleeved, cooler weather, rugby jumper are available and students are encouraged to wear these.

PROCEDURE

When selecting clothes for school, a level of modesty is to be observed and the following guidelines and standards for student dress apply:

1	Length of shorts or skirts or dresses are to be to the fingertips of arms when in a relaxed position, hanging at the side.
2	No midriff to be exposed
3	No cleavage to be exposed
